#### **OUR VIEWS & ASSESMENT**



## 9.Our Main Objectives Are:

1. Educational upliftment of poorest of the poor in the slums of Mumbai – who are most neglected by the Govt. agencies and by themselves – because of their ignorance.
2. Economic help to those who wish to stand on their own foot face the world by support of logistic, finance and training.
3. Help for survival to destitute women, orphans, and old aged by giving rations & day to expenses
4. Medical help by running charitable dispensaries, medical aid and counseling

## Our Source.

1. **Man power**-More than 50 enlightened and educated volunteers work on different projects with honesty, and sincerity to the extend that it is accepted by one and all in the area, where we work.
2. **Infrastructure**: We run all our activities from a welfare centre admeasuring 900 square feet in different shifts 07 days a week 15-16 hours daily- we hire, get facilities free of cost from other institutions and organizations.
3. **Finance**: We appeal and collect Donations, Zakat, Fitra, and Sadqat from our we-wishers in and around Mumbai for all our

activities, few activities are sponsored by one or the other group, individual or Trust.

## Our activities :

### Education: Free Computer Education

1. One Air-Conditioned Computer Institute with 10 computers, qualified faculties is imparting computer education to **X plus** students and youth making them employable at different levels or preparing them for higher computer courses. We teach **MS Word- and Tally** – till now about 3500 students benefited last six years. and about 1 / 3<sup>rd</sup> of them are employed. We propose to start higher courses from July '06 in Desk top publishing, Hardware, and Networking Management, BPO Modules.( Call centre training ) **10 new computers have been brought to upgrade the facilities**
2. **Hareem Girls Polytechnic:** To make our daughters and sisters prepared for any hardships in the life and capable of handling their own affairs --- a **Girls Polytechnic** is being run since last five years ---- Tailoring and Dress Making, Mehndi designing, Embroidery, Fabric Painting and other useful courses are run on cost to cost basis. Poor girls and Women are taught free of cost. Hundreds of girls have benefited. Poor girls – Widows – or **Deserted women are given Free Sewing Machines to earn their livelihood.**
3. **Adult Education Classes:** Free Adult Education Classes are being run since 8 years – dropout students or those who couldn't study or taught basics in languages, Maths Science and Moral education. **About 25-30 students benefit every year.**
4. **Educational Career Guidance Workshops:** To guide the upcoming generation in their career planning and choosing the particular course fit for them. Every year one career guidance workshop and counseling sessions is undertaken. Services of Experts are hired. **This year 160 students of SSC and HSC participated.**
5. **Talent Search and Scholarship Exam:** To make our students prepared to face different competitive exams for higher educations and jobs – on similar pattern an exam is being conducted since last two years a personal interview is also

conducting to judge the students, Cash prizes, Certificates are given to meritorious students needy but talented. Students are given educational scholarship. **Last year Rs.1.5 lacs were distributed in 28 students another 55 thousand were received in sponsorships.** This year our expectation is crossing 3.5 lacs in all.

6. **Coaching Classes:** For SSC and HSC Science Students at a highly subsidized fee. To enable students to achieve greater depth and insight in there important subjects such as Maths, Science & English. It will be in vacations & holidays only, so that students may continue their self studies. Teachers are best students, best teachers in coaching classes of the area.

7. **Zakat Fitra Distribution:**

- For educational scholarship below SSC ( X ) level
- Medical Aid
- Economic Help and Loans. Since last 8 years – ***a collective system of collection and distribution of Zakat Fitra***
- 500 + Fitra distribution on Chand Raat
- Zakat distribution through out the year
- New Clothes are distributed in poor families

8. **Family Counseling Centre:** Since last 8 years – one Mufti Sb, One Aalim, Few social workers and elders work tirelessly to unit the broken /near Break families – with every nominal fee – more than 75 families are Saved –Many bloody confrontations avoided. Many settlement on the Line of Quran and Sunnah Made. Local police is supportive, we Make the job easy for each other.

9. **Free Ration Distribution:** Since last 8 years about 80 families of Widows, sick and poor are supported to save them from hunger. Monthly ration of Rs 375/- value is given. There are many more needy in waiting for help.

10. **Charitable Dispensaries:**

1. There are Two Dispensaries running since last 6 years. One in Cheeta Camp another at Govandi. MBBS Doctors are employed. Thousands of patients are served in as less as Rs.5/- per day for medicine and consultation. At an average 75-80 patients report daily.
2. On consistent demand a **Homeopathic dispensary** is started on the auspicious day of Eid-e-Milad on 11<sup>th</sup> April '06 as large No of patients are turning to Alternative Medicine.
